Update- D1354 and D1355

Effective 3/1/2025, Molina Healthcare of Nebraska will be updating the claims payment system for D1354- Interim Caries Arresting Medicament Application per tooth and D1355- Caries Preventative Medicament Application per tooth. These updates are in alignment with industry standards and recommendations set by the American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry.

Only 3 of D1354 <u>or</u> D1355 are allowed per tooth per year. Providers are required to retain documentation demonstrating medical necessity. A prior authorization is required for the fourth application and must demonstrate the member has a high caries risk. A permanent restoration is not payable on the same tooth for three (3) months from the date of service of completed D1354 or D1355 per patient by the same provider, facility or group. D1354 and D1355 cannot be utilized on the same tooth for the same date of service.
